SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR

THE GARDENERS OF GREATER CLEVELAND will award a minimum of \$1,500 apiece scholarships to some graduating high school seniors in the Greater Cleveland area this 2024-2025 academic year. Applicants must have been enrolled in a horticulture program or exhibited substantial involvement in horticulture inside or outside of high school and intend to pursue a 2-year or 4-year college degree in horticulture or a closely related field in the "green industry" during the 2025-2026 college academic year.

Criteria for entering the competition for the scholarships are:

- 1. Students must have attained a 2.5 grade point average by the end of the first semester of their senior year.
- 2. At the time of the application, students must have been accepted by a college to major in horticulture, landscape architecture, or closely related field in the "green industry."
- 3. Scholarship money received should be used for college expenses such as tuition, room, board, and books to further the student's education.

Applications for a scholarship must be received no later than 7:00 PM, **Tuesday, April 1, 2025**. Successful applicants will be notified by mid-May. The details of the award ceremony for the recipients, their parents and teachers will be held at our regularly scheduled June meeting.

The Gardeners of Greater Cleveland began awarding scholarships in 2003 and intends to continue the awards on an annual basis. The money provided for these scholarships is raised by the club through plant sales, auctions, member contributions, and memorial gifts on behalf of deceased members of the club.

The application form in Microsoft Word format is attached so that students can download the application to a home or other computer. It is recommended that students reformat the application to fit their information. A current transcript and letters of recommendation must be included when applications are submitted. All parts of the application should be typed (or written in black ink) so that pages are legible when copied for distribution to our Scholarship Committee for evaluation. Interviews may be conducted by Zoom or in person.
