Teacher of the Year

Eligible candidates for the Ohio Teacher of the Year (OTOY) must:

- Hold a valid Ohio Professional Teaching License or a Career-Technical Teaching License,
- Be currently completing their tenth year or more of teaching,
- Be employed full-time in a state-approved public school, community school, or career-technical center,
- Work directly with students at least 50 percent of the time,
- Have not received previous Ohio Teacher of the Year recognition and,
- Plan to continue actively teaching.



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
