This session introduces educators to Ohio's Integrated Multi-Tiered System of Supports, the state's framework for delivering effective, data-informed academic and non-academic support to all students. Participants will learn the key components of the ODEW model— Universal Screening, Data-Based Decision Making, Continuum of Supports, Progress Monitoring, Team-Based Problem Solving, Shared Leadership, Professional Capacity, and Communication and Collaboration—and how these elements work together to meet the needs of students who are below, at, or above grade-level expectations.

# POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION SUPPORTS (PBIS)

### PBIS New Team Tier I - Virtual

This differentiated Tier I PBIS framework professional learning opportunity supports teams currently implementing or exploring the implementation of PBIS in their school to improve the climate. Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a framework that guides districts and schools in developing policies and practices that proactively define, teach, and support appropriate behavior. PBIS suggests a shift in thinking about behavior and discipline. Rather than telling students what NOT to do, emphasis is placed on teaching students what TO do.

### **PBIS Tier II Systems**

This training is designed for buildings implementing Tier I practices with 70% implementation on the Tier I Tiered Fidelity Inventory. Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports (PBIS) is a broad range of systemic and individualized strategies for achieving important social and learning outcomes in school communities while preventing problem behavior.

### **PBIS Tier II Interventions**

This two-day training is designed for buildings implementing Tier I practices with 70% implementation on the Tier I Tiered Fidelity Inventory. This training will include a review of various Tier II evidence-based interventions including Check-In Check-Out, Social and Academic Instructional Groups, Self-Monitoring, etc. For each intervention, participants will learn about the purpose which students would benefit most, how to ensure fidelity of implementation, and how to monitor if student progress is being made.

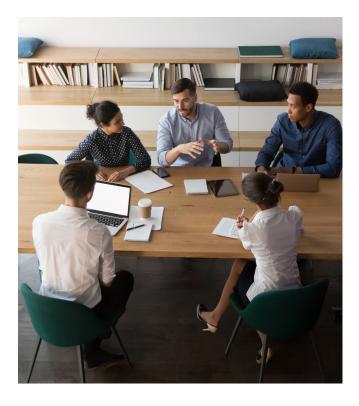
