**PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT**

***Parent's Part of the Agreement:***

I will agree to encourage and support my child by doing any or all of the following:

***Teacher's Part of the Agreement:***

- Communicate regularly with parents regarding my student's performance and achievement in reading and math.
- Communicate regularly with my student's other teachers regarding my student's performance and achievement.
- Be available to my student, parents and other teachers to share my expertise and listen to their ideas.
