

Mobile Options for Substitutes

Your Absence Management application offers two potential mobile app options for substitutes. Each app incorporates job-monitoring and job-acceptance tools, but there are also some notable differences between each. Review the Frontline Education mobile app and Jobulator details below:

Frontline Education Mobile App

The Frontline Education mobile app is a *free* job-monitoring tool that is available to any subs whose organization utilizes the Frontline Insights platform. The app checks and issues alerts for any available jobs offered through the system, and it allows a sub to accept the job directly through their smartphone.

Jobulator

Jobulator (<https://www.jobulator.com/>) is a *subscription service* from the makers of your Absence and Substitute Management system, and its billable service is available to any substitutes, regardless of their organization's setup. The app continuously and automatically checks for any available jobs offered through the system, and it can relay job notifications straight to your smartphone.
