 - a. 4 credits English
 - b. 4 credits Math, including Integrated Math 3 (Algebra 2)
 - c. 4 credits Social Studies, including, Modern World History, US History, Govt & Econ (must include financial literacy for Class of 2024 +2025)
 - d. 3 credits Science, including 1 Life Science, 1 Physical Science
 - e. 1 credit Art OR complete a Polaris Program
 - f. 0.50 credit Health
 - g. 0.50 credit PE or PE Waiver
 - h. 4 Elective credits Class of 2026 and beyond - must earn .50 Financial Literacy credit
2. **Show competency:** Earn a score of 684 or higher in ELA II **and** Integrated Math 1 (Algebra 1) End of Course Exams **OR** complete one of the below areas:
 - a. Demonstrate two-career focused activities:
FOUNDATIONAL Proficient scores on WebXams, A 12-point industry credential, OR A pre-apprenticeship or acceptance into an approved apprenticeship program,
SUPPORTING Work-based learning, required scores on WorkKeys, OR OhioMeansJob Readiness Seal
 - b. Enlist in the military
 - c. Complete college course work – Earn credit for one college-level math and/or college-level English course through Ohio’s free College Credit Plus Program.
3. **Show readiness:** Earn **two diploma** seals from the list below. At least **one** of the two must be **Ohio-designed:**
 - ☐ OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal (OHIO) -Meet requirements and criteria established for readiness seal, including demonstration of work-readiness and professional competencies.
 - ☐ Industry-Recognized Credential Seal (OHIO) – Earn approved industry-recognized credential that is aligned to job considered in demand.
 - ☐ College-Ready Seal (OHIO) - Earn remediation-free scores on the ACT (18 English, 22 Math) or SAT 1110.
 - ☐ Military Enlistment Seal (OHIO) – Provide evidence that student has enlisted in branch of the US Armed Forces.
 - ☐ Citizenship Seal (OHIO) - Earn a score of proficient or higher on the US History AND Government End of Course Exams, OR Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on an appropriate Advanced Placement Exam, OR Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” in an appropriate class in the college credit plus program.
 - ☐ Science Seal (OHIO) - Earn a score of proficient or higher on the Biology End of Course Exam, OR Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on an appropriate Advanced Placement Exam, OR Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” in an appropriate class in the college credit plus program.

Class of 2026 + Beyond

Earn all but one criteria

- * 4 Math credits (Fourth math must be > Algebra 2)
- * 4 Science credits (1 science must be advanced science)
- * 4 Social Studies credits
- * 3 World Languages Three sequential units of one world language, or no less than 2 sequential units of two world languages studied
- *GPA 3.5 unweighted GPA on a 4.0 scale
- *ACT/SAT ACT: Score of 27 or higher or SAT: Score of 1280 or higher
- *Seal Requirement Earn two additional diploma seals, not including Honors Diploma Seal
- * Experiential Learning Field Experience, OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal*, Portfolio or Work-Based Learning

☐ Seal of Biliteracy (OHIO) - Meet requirements and criteria, including proficiency requirements on assessments in a world language and English.

☐ Technology Seal (OHIO) - Earn score equivalent to proficient on an Advanced Placement Exam, OR Earn a "B" or higher in an appropriate course taken through the college credit course program, OR Complete courses offered through the district that meets guidelines developed by the state department.

☐ Community Service Seal (LOCAL) – Must complete 30 or more hours of community service during high school. Service hours must be approved by the Principal, and pre-approval is recommended. The following information needs to be completed in "forms" in powerschool: Name and description of the organization, description of the activity, and timeline for completing the service hours.

☐ Fine and Performing Arts Seal (LOCAL) – Must earn at least 2 credits of approved fine/performing arts program electives in one of the following disciplines: Visual Arts, Dance, Drama/Theatre, Music, or Media Arts during high school.

☐ Student Engagement Seal (LOCAL) – Must meet ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Must complete at least one full season of a school-sponsored varsity, junior varsity, or freshman sport. Coach must verify completion.
- Must participate in at least one full year of an NOHS club or organization. Advisor must verify completion.
